Services for Mrs. Ray Marks Rosenbloom, 370 N. Highland Ave., will be at 2:30 p.m. today at Griffin Funeral Home with Rabbi Susan Talve officiating. Burial will be in B'nai Israel Cemetery.

Mrs. Rosenbloom died Friday at Jackson-Madison County General Hospital after a short illness.

A lifelong resident of Jackson, she was the widow of Joseph L. Rosenbloom, former owner of Rosenbloom's Department Store, who died in 1952. Mrs. Rosenbloom was a graduate of Jackson High School and Memphis Conference Female Institute.

She was a member of Temple B'nai Israel, had held every office in its Temple Sisterhood and taught Sabbath School for many years.

Mrs. Rosenbloom was a former president of the Alexander Elementary School Parent-Teachers Association and a former member of the Jackson Womans Club. She had served as a Red Cross Gray Lady at the General Hospital for many years.

She leaves two sons, Dr. Alvin B. Rosenbloom of Nashville and Irving Rosenbloom of Jackson; six grandchildren, two step-grandchildren, 11 great-grandchildren and three step-great-grandchildren.
