Irwin Freedman was president of the congregation from 1955-1958. He was from Cincinnati, Ohio, and was the son of Henry and Rosa Freedman. Mr. Freedman came to Jackson in 1932. He was a veteran of World War II. Frieda Freedman was the daughter of Fannie and Alter Lindy. The Freedmans had two children, Anita and Harold. In 1940, Mr. and Mrs. Freedman opened Albert's Slipper Shop at 114 E. Lafayette Street in downtown Jackson. During the 1950s, they expanded to ladies clothing and changed the name to Albert's Dresses and Sportswear. After Mr. Freedman's death in 1973, their son, Harold, joined the business as co-owner and assisted his mother until the store closed in 1994. Harold Freedman served as president of the congregation from 1982-1984.
