In 1974, their son Harold joined the business as co-owner and assisted his mother until the store closed in 1994. In 1997, Mrs. Freedman moved to Nashville, Tennessee to be with her daughter and her family. She was a member of Congregation Ohabai Sholom Temple. Mrs. Freedman is preceded in death by her husband, Irwin Freedman; one sister, Rose Lindy Maranoff; three brothers, Sam Lindy, Jack Lindy and Aaron Lindy and their spouses. Survived by her children, Anita Freedman Taradash (Howard) of Nashville, Tennessee and Harold Freedman (Shirley) of Lenoir City, Tennessee. Mrs. Freedman is also survived by her grandchildren, Robin Dillon of Nashville, Tennessee, Michael Grollnek of Madison, Tennessee, Lana Faye Taradash of Boston, Massachusetts, Jonathan Freedman of Hartford, Connecticut, Mark Freedman of Dallas, Texas and the late Ian Kinney of Knoxville, Tennessee; great grandchildren, Lauren Meredith Dillon, Joseph Aaron Dillon, Madeline Jean Scheiner and Amelia Isabelle Scheiner.
