Sam Bergel Dead At 74

Services for Samuel Bergel, 74, retired auto parts dealer and active member of civic and charitable organizations of Jackson, will be at 2 p. m. today at Griffin Funeral Home with Rabbi James Cohn and Rev. David Olhausen officiating. Burial will be in B'Nai Israel Cemetery.

Mr. Bergel died Friday morning at the Jackson-Madison County General Hospital.

He was born in Providence, R.I., but moved to Jackson at an early age. He was owner of Sam Bergel Auto Parts Company before selling the business, but maintained his part-owner's interest in the Jackson Scrap Metal Company.

Mr. Bergel was a charter member and life member of the Jackson Area Council on Alcoholism and Drug Dependency (JACO), and member of Rotary International, Knights of Pythias, Scottish Rite Mason and Al Chymia Shrine.

He was a former member of the Jackson Jaycees and Chamber of Commerce, and honorary member of Jackson Police Department and Tennessee Sheriff's Association.

Mr. Bergel was also an active member of Elks Lodge 192, Woodmen of the World, the Bill Baxter Bible Class and the Harvest Years Club. He was a past member of the Civil Air Patrol.

He leaves a daughter, Mrs. Joanne Goldstein of Jackson; a brother, Julius Bergel of Denver, Colo.; a sister, Mrs. Pearl Cooper of Pittsburg, Pa., and four grandchildren.
